## <u>Website</u>

## Learning Logs

Children from Y2, Y3 and Y4 are given learning logs for homework. The idea of this is that they can follow up on their own personal interests. They are expected to provide one piece of work per week. We realize that some children struggle to think of ideas to work on so we will be making suggestions in school which they can take up or they can choose to work on their own ideas. The work can be:

Topic related, something from the news; personal news; handwriting; spelling; maths; art or anything at all provided that it is produced to a high standard.

# <u>Parking</u>

Northumbria police are currently working with the school in an attempt to ensure that parking is not causing a danger to our families. The situation is getting worse and someone will eventually be involved in an accident. We have received numerous complaints from local residents. I ask you once again to co-operate with us in the interests of the children's safety.

#### **Forums**

At the beginning of each term class forums are held. These are short meetings where the learning for the term and class routines are explained to parents. <u>Coming along to the forums gives a clear signal to children that learning is important and also enables parents to help their children at home</u>. #### **Outdoor Learning**

Each class will be spending a whole day each week learning in our outdoor village. This is in order to bring learning to life. The children will be presented with situations and experiences that will stimulate thinking skills, problem solving and team work, which will ultimately lead to much deeper learning than can be reached by sitting at a desk.

#### **Attendance**

Please make sure that your child attends school every day unless he/she is ill. Good attendance is very important as attendance figures are recorded and will follow your child throughout his/her school career. If your child is ill please telephone the office on the first day of absence. Punctuality is also very important because it helps to establish lifelong good habits, gets the day of to a good start for your child and prevents him/her missing out on information about the coming day.

#### <u>Holidays</u>

Holidays in term time are no longer allowed by the government. Head Teachers may only grant leave of absence in exceptional circumstances. Please do not ask as refusal often offends.

#### **Contact Details**

It is vital that your contact details are correct and up to date. Please collect a change of address/contact form from the foyer to let us know of any change to your details.

#### **Head Lice**

At this time of year had lice are a nuisance, which can affect anyone, regardless of how clean their hair is. It is advisable for long hair to be tied back at all times.
